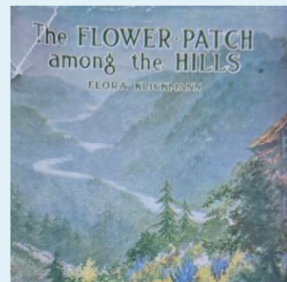


A good climb up through Coppett Hill Nature Reserve with its panoramic views; & varied walk back along the Wye.
